Points may only be obtained by eligible teams in their own Region and are distributed according to each team's classification in the FEI Jumping Nations Cup™ Youth Competition according to the following scale:

In case teams are placed equal with any other team during any of the FEI Jumping Nations Cup™ Youth Competitions, the points for the places in question are added and divided equally among the teams concerned, team(s) thereby obtaining its/their portion of the points. The second decimal place is rounded up from .005 and rounded down from 0.004.
