Jumping

- A) Athletes and/or Horses that participated in the 2013 FEI European Championship for Young Riders and Juniors in their respective age category are qualified to compete.
- B) Athletes (of the appropriate age) and/or Horses that have completed the first round of a Grand Prix competition at any 2013 or 2014 European CSI1*/CSI2* outdoor event or CSIO1*/CSIO2* outdoor event with a score of not more than eight penalties are qualified to compete.
- C) Athletes (of the appropriate age) and/or Horses that have completed the first round of a Grand Prix competition at any 2013 or 2014 European CSI3*, CSI4* or CSI5* outdoor event or the first round of a Nations Cup or Grand Prix competition at any CSIO3*, CSIO4* or CSIO5* event with a score of not more than eight penalties are qualified to compete.
- D) Athletes and/or Horses that have completed the first round of a Grand Prix competition in their own Category at a 2013 or 2014 CSIY/CSIJ outdoor event with a score of not more than eight penalties are qualified to compete.
- Athletes and/or Horses that have completed the first or second round of a Nations Cup competition in their own category at any 2013 or 2014 CSIOY/CSIOJ outdoor event with a score of not more than eight penalties, or that have completed the first round of the Grand Prix competition in their own category with a score of not more than eight penalties, are qualified to compete.
- F) In addition, the main competition at the following events of the European Youngster Cup U25 series will act as a qualifier for both Junior Athletes and Young Riders who complete the first round of the competition with no more than eight penalties.

- I) In addition, the following competitions at the CSIO3* Odense (DEN) will act as a qualifier for Athletes who complete the first round of the competition with no more than eight penalties:

- J) In addition, Competition No: 8 at the CSI2* Chepstow (GBR) on 05.05.2014 will act as a qualifier for Junior Athletes who complete the first round of the competition with no more than eight penalties.
- K) In addition, the following competitions at the CSI3* Arezzo (ITA) will act as a qualifier for both Junior Athletes and Young Rider who complete the first round of the competition with no more than eight penalties.
