<b>Benzydamine</b>	Banned Substance	Controlled Medication	Anti-inflammatory with analgesic properties, low potential for abuse
<b>Caffeine</b>	Not Listed	Controlled Medication	Metabolites also included as prohibited substances
<b>Cyclosporine implants</b>	Controlled Medication	Controlled Medication	Eye drops and implants play a recognized role. Need to fill out Form 2. Lab monitoring and review during 2015
<b>GnRH Vaccine</b>	Not Listed	Not Listed	Request made to Veterinary Committee for such vaccine use to be recorded in FEI Passport
<b>Oxytocin</b>	Not listed	Controlled Medication	Considered as having potential for abuse, with potential welfare risk
<b>Sotalol</b>	Banned Substance	Controlled Medication	Beta-blocker with a low potential for abuse
<b>Vanillyl Butyl Ether</b>	Not Listed	Controlled Medication	Heating agent with a low potential for abuse
