

Alpe Adria Eventing Trophy



- 1. The Alpe Adria Eventing Trophy (AAET) is a "triangular Eventing trophy" in which riders of bordering nations such as Italy, Slovenja and Austria compete. The Alpe Adria Trophy's aim is to attract many young and amateur eventers or whoever would like to participate or begin this discipline. For this reason our plan is to organize competitions that host lower categories. The coordinators of the AAET will be Mr. Manfred Wakonig, Mr. Martin Jager and Mr. Claudio Berra.
- 2. The trophy will consist of 6 (six) competitions: 3 (three) in Italy (Friuli Venezia Giulia region) and 3 (three) in Austria (Carinthya) in which anyone who is licensed within the Italian, Austrian or Slovenian federation can compete. All the Federations approve the rules and accept to participate in the trophy.
- 3. At the end of the trophy there will be the Alpe Adria International Eventing Trophy Champion, junior and senior, only if these will participate at least in 3 (three) competitions of which at least 1 (one) in homeland and 2 (two) abroad. In this case Slovenian riders will be considered as Austrian riders.
- 4. For those riders who compete in more than 3 (three) competitions, the worst scores 1-3 will not be considered as per the rules and minimum request in paragraph 3.
- 5. Every event will be run according to the national regulations, except for the exemptions for the AAET, in paragraph 11.
- 6. For those who would like to participate to the AAET, there will be an entry fee of 10 Euro per event and this tax will go directly to the AAET committee and will be extra with respect to the normal entry fee as stated in the event schedule, in which the rider competes. If a rider wishes to compete with more horses in one event, he can with max 3 (three) horses

and for the AAET the best result of the event will count. He will have to pay 10 Euro for each horse if he wants to participate in the trophy with all horses, otherwise the result of the horse that was entered in the trophy will be kept in consideration.

7. Every federation has to select a national nominee for the AAET who will be responsible for the entries of the competitors of his nation, check that everything is regular and send them to the organizing committee within FIFTEEN DAYS from the beginning of the event. The entries will be closed by the national nominee, within the hours 24.00 of the SIXTEENTH DAY before the event.

8. The AAET will run categories 1-2-3 in Italy and categories AL-A-L in Austria, and the scores will be calculated according to the category and to the rider's "licence" as recorded in the following table:

To have more competitors taking part in all of the AAET competitions, there will be extra points added to the normal points that the rider would normally obtain:

9. The AAET scores will be calculated this way: every rider takes the best three negative scores that will be multiplied for the coefficient of his event and category (see table at par.8), and then the points of allowance of third event in Austria and Italy will be taken away. At the

end of the six competitions programmed, the points will be summed and the points will be used to do the final result, and from the final results two separate rankings will come out: one for the JUNIOR riders and one for the SENIOR riders and the prizes of "Champion of the Alpe Adria International Eventing Trophy" will be given. The rider that is first in the ranking will be the rider with less negative points, considering the 3 best scores. In case of ex-aequo the winner will be the rider that has the best score in the last competition.

10. Prize money and prizes in kind:

- Prize money: the AAET committee will award prize money of 10.000 Euro, or more depending on the number of entries and this will be divided as follows:
 - a) 50% to the Junior
 - b) 50% to the Senior
- Prizes in kind:
 - 1. To the 1st, junior and senior, the champion trophy and rosette
 - 2. To 2nd and 3rd prize and rosette
 - 3. To 4th and 5th prize and rosette
 - 4. A plague will be awarded to all the participants of the AAET

In each competitions of the AAET the first 3 riders of the AAET of each category will receive a rosette.

Final AAET prize giving will take place at date and place to be decided, during a gala dinner where all the prizes will be given, in the Nation with the most participating riders, after the last event, in a place that is convenient for everyone.

Any rider who will not personally attend the final prize giving ceremony, will lose the prize money, but will have the right to receive the prizes in kind. An exception will be granted for documented impossibilities to attend to the ceremony that has to be sent to the AAET coordinators within 7 days before the ceremony begins.

11. Exemptions from the national rules:

- a) From the Austrian regulations: in category 3 L only, riders can ride horses (not pony) in the Dressage test with the double bridle. These will result in the final classification.
- b) From the Italian regulations: riders with Italian 2G CCE and Austrian R3 Kader can ride horses in all categories of all the ages, but not medium or expert horses and horses which are qualified for CIC1* or superior. These will be included in the competition results but will not receive any prizes.
- 12. In accordance with the national federations, all the riders of the AAET will be given a free guest license if the event is not held in their own nation. However, the request for a guest

license must be made by each national federation to the national federation where the competition is held.

To make the Guest License request easier, every federation will accept the entries in a cumulative form (attached) with the list of riders and horses participating to every single event – signed by the Regional Committee or NF – that will also be valid as entry form.

- 13. Every organizing committee wishing to take part as an event organizer in the AAET , has to pay:
 - a) 200 Euro (not refundable)
 - b) 1.000 Euro as a guarantee for the competition organization, that will be given back at the end of the competition. If the event does not take place, with the exception of cancellation due to meteorological conditions which have been declared by the Technical Delegate of the competition, the money guarantee will be kept by the AAET committee.
- 14. All matters which are not foreseen in this rule book and decisions regarding objections will be taken by the 3 members of the AAET organizing committee, always with respect of national Eventing regulations of the Nation that hosts the event.
