THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- 5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

Each Nation may enter a maximum of 6 single competitors with a maximum of 2 horses per entry on the nominated entry list. However only 3 single competitors with a maximum of 1 horse per competitor can be entered on the definite entry list and allowed to participate at the event. $\sqrt{}$

If a Nation can enter only 2 drivers, they will be entered as a Team. $\sqrt{}$

Individual Drivers

A Nation unable to send a team may enter a driver with a maximum of 2 horses of which only 1 will participate at the event and placed on the definite entry list.

Only after all the teams have been allocated will the additional individual drivers be considered by the O.C.

Horses

Horses must be at least 6 years old (Art. 911.1.). NFs may enter 2 horses per competitor on the nominated entry list but only 1 may participate in the competition and listed on the definite entry list. $\sqrt{}$

A spare horse from the Nominated List may be entered per National Team. The competitor who uses the spare Horse will be eligible for the individual classification, as well as for the team classification. The spare horse can only be substituted once, not later than 1 hour before the start of competition A and notified in writing to the Organiser. $\sqrt{}$

FACILITIES OFFERED

a) COMPETITORS AND CHEFS D'EQUIPE

The accommodation is at the drivers' charge.

A list of recommended hotels, costs and distances from the show ground is provided in the annex.

Team members (competitors, 1 groom per competitor, 1 Chef d'Equipe, 1 veterinarian and 1 trainer per team) will receive meal coupons from Wednesday at midday till Monday at midday to be used at the show grounds (see Art. 933.2). Extra meal tickets can be bought. $\sqrt{}$

b) GROOMS

The O.C. can provide upon request accommodation free of charge in caravans very close to the stables (4 persons every caravan) for a maximum of 28 people. Requests must be sent with nominated entries at the latest.

c) HORSES

Stabling arrangements in individual boxes (3x3m), from Monday 18^{th} at 12.00 a.m. to Monday 25^{th} 12.00 a.m. Cost to be paid by OC. The OC will provide each competitor with the first bedding and then 2 extra bales of straw or shavings on request. Because of security reasons, all horses will be stabled in boxes provided by the OC. Competitors are not authorized to set up their own loose-boxes. It will be possible to buy hay and oat at the show grounds at the current market price. The OC will not allow a reimbursement for transport expenses. $\sqrt{}$

d) Welcome

The time and date of arrival of drivers and horses and their means of transport must be given to the OC in order to facilitate them upon arrival.

e) Local transportation arrangements from Hotel to Show grounds

A shuttle service will be organized for Judges from the hotel to show grounds.
